#### **SPEAKERS BUREAU:**

On Wed., August 17th, **Joann Teuscher** introduced as Speaker **Don Plotts**, President of North Central State College. Mr. Plotts spoke of the addition that is being completed on one of the main buildings of the college — a Student Center. He stated that the challenge of our society is that the workforce skills don't add up to the skills needed by employers. He said that the attainment rate of a Baccalaureate Degree is only 9%; of an Associate Degree is 17%. Over

60% of the students need remedial courses prior to entering North Central State College.

He spoke of the new addition to the college — a downtown branch called the Urban Center, serving 9,000 people downtown. He cited that the Urban Center is offering classes for college students, classes for those people 60+ and Lunch and Learn lunchtime seminars beginning in August. The Fall Quarter begins Sept. 19th. He stated that the Kehoe Center in Shelby is undergoing a 1 million dollar plus renovation to house the Business Administration Dept. Then plans are for the building of a hotel and restaurant to serve the needs of the community and North Central State College.
